Senior artists displaying works at Tri-County Mall

The eighth annual Senior Art Show will be held Oct. 15-26 at Tri County Mall, 11700 Princeton Pike.

Sponsored each year by the Council on Aging of Southwestern Ohio, the event showcases the work of senior artists who live in Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton and Warren counties. To qualify for the show, artists must have been over the age of 60 when they completed their entries and the works cannot have been shown prior to this event. Some 115 artists have entered works for this year's show.

The show will be on the 2nd floor of the mall, across from the food court. It will be open from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 12 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Sunday.
