**RFP Title: Elderly Services Program – Home Medical Equipment**

### Questions & Answers

Q1: Is this RFP for Personal Emergency Response Systems or Medication Management Programs?

*A: The purpose of the HME RFP is to contract with providers to furnish medical equipment and supplies. Equipment such as medication dispensers are included in this RFP; however, monitoring and management of medication intake are not covered. This RFP is not to contract with a PERS agency for medication monitoring.*

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Q2: Of the approximately 1400+ folks utilizing the home medical equipment during 2017, as detailed by zip code in the RFP, approximate how many/what percentage are medication dispensers?

*A: This information is not available at this time.*

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Q3: Do I need to submit a proposal if I am a current provider?

*A: Being a current provider does not guarantee a new contract for ESP Home Medical Equipment. In order to be considered for a new ESP contract for Home Medical Equipment you must submit a Proposal no later than **Noon EST on October 9, 2018**. We urge the providers to plan accordingly to ensure they are submitting their proposal prior to the date and time deadlines. Proposals received after 12:00pm, EST on Oct 9 will not be accepted. This is a firm deadline.*

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Q4: Some items are not present on the pricing sheets. For example, ramps. Are they included in this RFP?
