NUTRITION PROGRAM

If you are 60 or older, live in Ohio and have an annual income of less than 185% of the federal poverty level, you can apply for the 2025 Ohio Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program!

Participants receive \$50 each year to be used to purchase fresh, locally grown vegetables, fruits, honey and fresh cut herbs at participating farmers' markets and roadside stands.

TIMELINE:

- Applications available April 16th
- Begin redeeming benefits May 15th
- Recipient applications close September 30th
- Last day to redeem benefits is November 30th

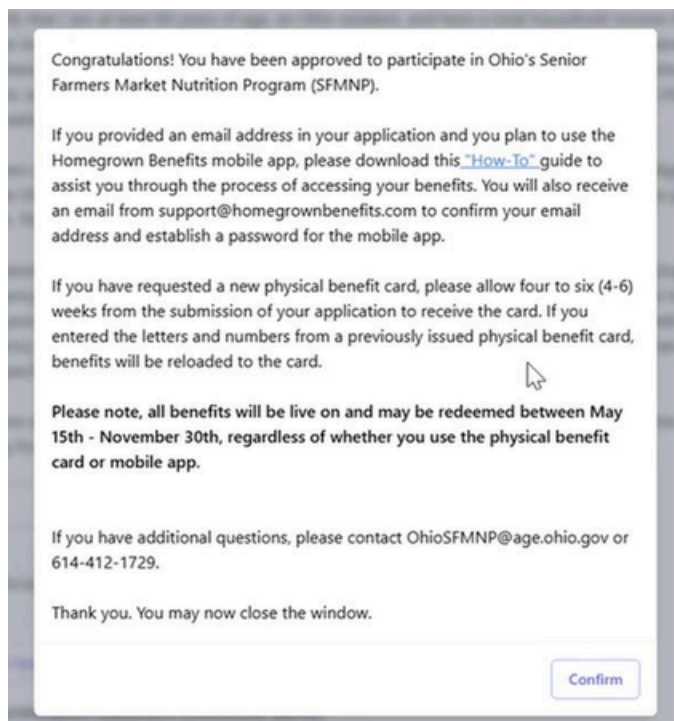

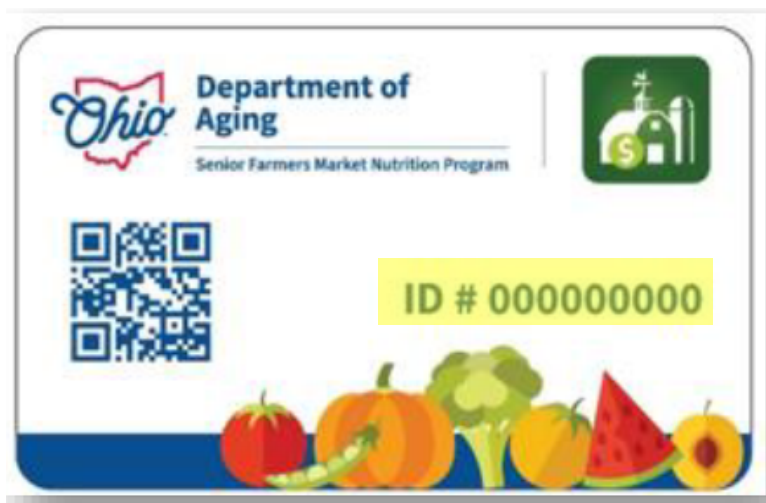

2 HOMEGROWN BENEFITS PORTAL

Once the online application is complete, the screen to the right will populate. Ohio Department of Aging will email a notification of approval which will include a link to register (or login if already an active user). You must download the Homegrown Benefits app from the app store. Next you will use your email address as your user name and create a password for logging in. Once your profile is set up, benefits will be immediately available.



3 BENEFIT CARD



If choosing to use your Homegrown Benefits card, benefits will be immediately available upon completion of application. Participants with cards from previous years can put in the ID# from last year's card when completing the application. If a participant requires a new card mailed, please allow 4-6 weeks to receive. Benefits will be uploaded to card and available starting May 15th.
