Brent Pease

Brent Pease is an IRONMAN triathlete, endurance coach and Executive Director of The Kyle Pease Foundation, which enhances the lives of people with disabilities through sports. Alongside his brother Kyle, Brent has completed over 100 events, including six IRONMANs, inspiring diverse audiences with their story of perseverance and brotherhood.



Kyle Pease

Kyle Pease is a six-time IRONMAN finisher and acclaimed author, recognized for his advocacy for disability inclusion. Born with cerebral palsy, he demonstrates that passion and perseverance can overcome physical limitations. Alongside his brother Brent, he became the first athlete with cerebral palsy to complete the IRONMAN World Championship in Kona, Hawaii, inspiring many worldwide.
