### Dr. Irene Hamrick Bio

Dr. Irene Hamrick earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Western Carolina University before advancing her education at East Carolina University School of Medicine, where she completed her residency in Family Medicine and a fellowship in Geriatric Medicine. She has served as the Geriatric Fellowship Director, where she taught Geriatrics and led the Division of Geriatrics.

During her eight years at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, she developed an interdisciplinary teaching program centered on geriatrics. In 2019, she was Chair of the Office of Geriatrics at the University of Cincinnati as well as Chief of Geriatrics and Palliative Care at the Cincinnati VA.

Dr. Hamrick's extensive experience in Geriatric Medicine covers a wide range of settings, including hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and home visits. With more than 25 years as a Medical Director, her research interests include falls, osteoporosis, dementia, diabetes, and dehydration.
