If you are 60 or older, live in Butler, Clinton, Clermont, Hamilton or Warren County and have an annual income of less than 185% of the federal poverty level, you can apply for the **2023 USDA Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program!**

Participants will receive \$50 in coupons to redeem this growing season for fresh, locally grown vegetables, fruits, honey and fresh cut herbs at participating farmers' markets and roadside stands.

Council on Aging representatives will hold designated distribution events where older adults may apply and at the same time receive their coupons. List of events on back of flyer.

Individuals are required to re-apply for the program each year. Applicants for the 2023 program will not be able to apply online or through the mail.
